# 2019 CHELCO College Scholarship Program Rules Deadline for applications is Feb. 15, 2019

### Procedure:

- Three, one-time scholarships of \$1,000 each will be awarded.
- Applications will be accepted January 1 through Feb. 15. Scholarship winners will be announced in April.
- Applications will be screened by three judges from colleges in the area.
- Finalists will be interviewed by the judges, who will select the three winners.

### **Selection Criteria:**

- Scholastic achievements as determined by applicant's grade point average (GPA) and college test scores.
- Applicant's involvement in school and community activities includes demonstrating leadership, service diversity and achievement.
- Applicant's ability to communicate career and life goals in a letter and interview will be considered.
- Applicant's need for financial aid.

#### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be either a member of CHELCO or the spouse/dependent child of a CHELCO member. Applicants must live in a residence served by CHELCO.
- Applicants may be graduating high school seniors or adults accepted or enrolled in college or technical institution of higher education.
- Students who have received CHELCO scholarships through the Northwest Florida State College Foundation are not eligible. Previous winners of the CHELCO College Scholarship are not eligible.
- **High school seniors** must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and must provide college test scores (ACT, SAT). GPA must be certified by the guidance counselor.
- Adults currently attending college must have a 2.5 GPA and provide a certified transcript.
- Adults enrolling in college for the first time must either A) submit a high school transcript with a minimum 2.50 GPA if they have been out of high school less than five years or (B) provide college acceptance test scores (i.e. Postsecondary Education Readiness Test (PERT) or other college placement test) or (C) submit a college transcript from previous attendance within 3 years with a minimum 2.50 GPA.



### Limitations

- Applicant must be accepted or enrolled in an accredited college, community college, technical school or continuing education institution at the time of the application.
- Scholarships are one-time awards and are not renewable. A scholarship recipient may not apply in future years.
- Scholarship funds must be claimed within 12 months of the award date, unless an extension is requested and granted by CHELCO administration.
- Scholarship funds are paid directly to the educational institution for credit to the student's account. If a student does not use the funds, they must be returned to CHELCO.
- For high school seniors, scholarships are awarded in the spring but are contingent upon successful and timely graduation.

### Applications must be accompanied by:

- Applications will be judged as submitted. Completed application with appropriate signatures required. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- Certified high school, college transcript and/or college placement test scores.
- 300-500 word essay on how being selected for the CHELCO College Scholarship would benefit your goals in life and career.
- Free Application for Student Federal Aid (FAFSA) award letter or most recent IRS income tax return and completed financial assistance questionnaire.
- Applicants submitting school and community service activities should be descriptive in leadership positions and duties performed. See examples below.
