Sign up for bank draft for a chance to win a kayak

If you would like a chance to win a kayak, with a built in seat, a paddle and valued over \$300, sign up for CHELCO's bank draft payment plan. All participants in the program as of Aug. 31 will be eligible to win.

With bank draft, your payment is automatically deducted from your checking account. You save postage, and your bill gets paid on time. You receive your billing information, including the date of the deduction, either by mail or email.

For the ultimate in convenience, add paperless billing. You will receive an email when your bill is ready. If you are on bank draft, the bill will automatically be paid on the due date. If not, simply click on the link in the electronic bill and pay online. If you enter your checking account routing and account information to pay the bill, there is no charge. You can save this information so you do not have to enter it every month. If you use a debit or credit card, there is a \$3 fee.

If you have a CHELCO online account, log on and select Draft Payment Options for autopay. For paperless, select Account Management and then the Paperless Billing tab.

Make sure CHELCO can contact you

It is important that we have your current contact information. Check your bill to see if the phone number we have associated with your account is correct. You can change the phone number by accessing your account from our website, or you can call (850) 892-2111 to update information.

If you do not have a land line and your primary number is a cell phone, we would like to make sure it is labeled as a mobile number and not a home number.

Call 811 before you dig

Whether it's a simple deck addition or a landscaping masterpiece, summer weather is great for outdoor improvements. But if your projects include digging, like planting a tree, it's important to call 811 at least three days in advance to find where utility lines run. The service is free, prevents the inconvenience of having services interrupted and may help avoid serious injury and avoid potential repair cost.

CHELCO selects three \$1,000 scholarship winners

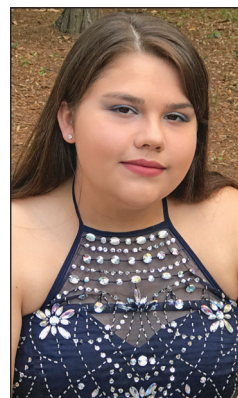
CHELCO has chosen three \$1,000 scholarship recipients.

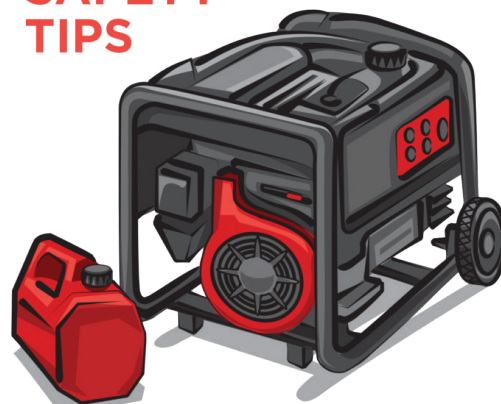

GENERATOR SAFETY TIPS



Never connect a standby generator into your home's electrical system. There are only two safe ways to connect a standby generator to your equipment.

Stationary Generator:

An approved generator transfer switch, which keeps your house circuits separate from the electric utility, should be installed by a professional.

Portable Generator:

Plug appliances directly into the outlet provided on the generator.

Set up and run your generator in a well-ventilated area outside the home. Make sure it's out and away from your garage, doors, windows and vents. The carbon monoxide generated is **deadly**.

Use a heavy-duty extension cord to connect electric appliances to the outlet on the generator.

Start the generator first **before** connecting appliances.

CHELCO participated in three American Cancer Society Relay for Life events this year: Crestview, Niceville and Walton County. More than 35 CHELCO employees volunteered time to raise money and awareness to fight back against cancer.

CHELCO's third annual charity golf tournament March 31 at Blackstone Golf Course raised more than \$8,500. Those funds were split between

Relay for Life and the American Heart Association Heart Walk event, which will be held Sept. 29.
